ACTION

- (1) In accordance with Article 26(2) of Regulation (EU) No 575/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 26 June 2013 on prudential requirements for credit institutions and investment firms as it forms part of retained EU law (the "CRR"), the Prudential Regulation Authority ("the PRA") has decided to grant Lloyds Banking Group Plc the permission on a consolidated basis, to include the interim profits for the period beginning 1 January 2023 and ending on 30 September 2023 in Common Equity Tier 1 capital prior to the company's formal decision confirming the final profit or loss for the financial year beginning 1 January 2023.
- (2) This permission is granted on the basis that the conditions set out in Article 26(2) of the CRR have been met and continue to be met. If any of those conditions ceases to be met, the PRA may re-consider the terms of this permission, or revoke this permission in whole or in part

Effect

(3) This permission takes effect on 24 October 2023 and expires on the date of the formal decision confirming the final profit or loss for the financial year starting 1 January 2023.
