



Terms and Conditions

1. Any UK secondary school ("You") is eligible to enter the Bank, Camera, Action Competition (the "Competition").
2. By entering the Competition You are accepting these Terms and Conditions.
3. The competition is open to 11-18 year olds i.e. Key Stages 3 - 5.
4. You may have up to a maximum of five students in each team but there is no limit to the number of people that can be shown in your film submission (the "Film"). There is no limit on the number of teams that can be entered per school.
5. The team must be supported by a teacher at the school.
6. Film and idea development and production should be led by the students with guidance from their teacher.
7. By entering the Competition you are confirming that You will obtain the written consent of the parents or legal guardians of the students in your team/any other students appearing in your Film, as set out in the Consent Form.
8. You are responsible for the cost and expense (if any) of making your Bank, Camera, Action Film.
9. Films must be on the subject of "What will money be like in the future?".
10. Films must be between 1 – 3 minutes long including titles and credits.
11. All entries must be submitted via the free service WeTransfer.
12. Films must be able to be opened on a standard Windows Desktop in one of the following formats: MP4 video file (.mp4, .m4v, .3pg), QuickTime Movie file (.mov), Windows Media formats (.wmv).
13. The closing dates and times for submitting a registration entry form for the Competition is **23.59 on Monday 8 October 2018** and for submitting your Film is **23.59 on Monday 10 December 2018**. Entry forms and Films received after these dates and times will not be considered.
