



Terms and Conditions - Storyboard Category

- 1. Any UK primary school, secondary school, sixth form college or further education college ("You") is eligible to enter the Bank, Camera, Action Competition (the "Competition").
- 2. By entering the Competition You are accepting these Terms and Conditions.
- 3. The Competition is open to 7-19 year olds i.e. Key Stages 2 5 / Primary 3-7 and Secondary 1-6).
- 4. Students may enter either the Storyboard or Film Category but the <u>same</u> student cannot enter both Competitions.
- 5. We can only accept one storyboard per entrant. There is not limit on the number of entries per school.
- 6. All storyboarding must be the work of the student with guidance from their teacher.
- 7. By entering the Competition you are confirming that You will obtain the written consent of the parents or legal guardians of the student, as set out in the Consent Form.
- 8. You are responsible for the cost and expense (if any) of making your Bank, Camera, Action Storyboard.
- 9. Storyboards must be on the subject of 'The Changing Workplace: same spaces, new realities'.
- 10. The emphasis of the Storyboard Category is on creating a visual representation of a film and should show how it will look on screen. Students should draw their films frame by frame including a short script using the template provided. When judging we will be focused on the ideas represented, however, drawings need to be of a high enough standard for us to understand the story structure.
- 11. All storyboards must be between 9 and 12 frames using the template on our website.
- 12. All entries must be submitted as an attachment via email to filmcompetition@bankofengland.co.uk.

 Postal entries will not be accepted.
- 13. The closing dates and times for submitting a registration entry form for the Competition is 23.59 on Friday 6 November 2020 and for submitting your Storyboard and Consent Form is 23.59 on Monday 14 December 2020. Entry forms, Storyboards and Consent Forms received after these dates and times will not be considered.
