



## Terms and Conditions Film Category

1. Any UK primary school, secondary school, sixth form college or further education college (“You”) is eligible to enter the Bank, Camera, Action Competition (the “Competition”).
2. By entering the Competition You are accepting these Terms and Conditions.
3. The competition is open to 7-19 year olds i.e. Key Stages 2 – 5 / Primary 3-7 and Secondary 1-6).
4. Students may enter either the Film or Storyboard Category but the same students cannot enter both categories
5. You may have up to a maximum of five students in each team but there is no limit to the number of people that can be shown in your film submission (the “Film”). There is no limit on the number of teams that can be entered per school.
6. The team must be supported by a teacher at the school.
7. Film and idea development and production should be led by the students with guidance from their teacher.
8. By entering the Competition you are confirming that You will obtain the written consent of the parents or legal guardians of the students in your team/any other students appearing in your Film, as set out in the [Consent Form](#). Films submitted without a valid consent form will not be considered.
9. You are responsible for the cost and expense (if any) of making your Bank, Camera, Action Film.
10. Films must be on the subject of **‘The Changing Workplace: same spaces, new realities.**
11. Films must be between 1 – 3 minutes long including titles and credits.
12. All entries must be submitted via the free service WeTransfer.
13. Films must be able to be opened on a standard Windows Desktop in one of the following formats: MP4 video file (.mp4, .m4v, .3pg), QuickTime Movie file (.mov), Windows Media formats (.wmv).
14. All films should be developed, filmed and edited observing appropriate social distancing measures in line with government guidance.
