We will consider applications related to all aspects of macroeconomic forecasting. Topics include, but are not limited to:

- Data uncertainty and forecast communication
- Nowcasting/ monitoring of current economic conditions
- Conditional forecasts, scenario analysis, forecasting risk
- Forecasting in the presence of structural breaks
- Forecasting inflation, exchange rates; finance and forecasting
- Big data, unstructured data, high-frequency data

Participants are expected to cover their own accommodation and travel expenses. However, a number of hotel rooms at a discounted rate has been reserved, and partial contributions towards travel expenses may become available.
