Income Distribution, Wealth Distribution and Central Bank Policies

The Bank of England and the Department of Economics at the LSE are organizing a conference bringing together researchers studying the two-way relationship between central bank policies and heterogeneity in agents' incomes and wealth. The conference is to be held in London on February the 28th, 2020.

The scientific committee invites both theoretical and applied submissions on any aspect of this linkage, including but not limited to:

- The role of heterogeneity in income/wealth for the transmission of monetary and prudential policies.
- Distributional consequences of conventional and unconventional monetary and prudential policies.

The conference is organised by Cristiano Cantore (Bank of England), Michael Kumhof (Bank of England), Benjamin Moll (LSE) and Ricardo Reis (LSE).

The deadline for submissions is the 30th of September 2019. Full papers should be submitted to heterogeneityconf2020@gmail.com. Authors of successful submissions will be notified by early November 2019.
