### PROVISIONAL REGULATIONS.

Out Cash

The OUT CASH is the Gold Coin and Silver Coin in the joint charge of-

- (1) The Cashiers and the In-Tellers' Office (Gold and Silver Coin in the Banking Department):
- The Cashiers and the Bullion Office (Gold Coin in the Issue Department): and
- (3) The Cashiers and the Chief Cashier's Office (Silver Coin in the Issue Department).

Where stored

This Cash will be found in the various Safes in the Treasury and in the several Vaults referred to below.

The number of bags found in each Safe or Vault must be compared, as far as possible, with the figures given in the "Banking Cash Book" and "Issue Cash Book," respectively, and the making up of the totals in these books checked. (The Director should see that any alterations in these Books have been duly initialled.)

TREASURY Office Bags.

After the cash remaining at the close of business has been put up into bags of £1,000 (gold) and £100 (silver), the odd cash in each office is put up into "Office Bags," and the amount of each bag noted on a label attached thereto. These bags are placed in the Inner Treasury, the Bullion Office "Issue" bag in Safe No. 79 and the remaining bags in a Safe set apart for the purpose; the amounts on the labels are entered by the Cashiers in their "Issue Cash Book" and "Banking Cash Book," respectively.

The contents of two at least of these Office Bags must be verified, and the amounts compared with the entries in the books mentioned.

Banking and

The Banking Gold Coin in the Treasury, if any, is contained in Safe No. 93. The Issue Gold Coin is contained in Safes Nos. 71 to 92.

The number of bags in all these Safes must be counted and the contents of one or more bags of Banking, if any, and two or more of Issue, must be verified.

The Banking Silver Coin is contained in Safes Nos. 93 to 139. Six, at least, of Banking and these Safes must be opened, and the number of bags counted.

> The Silver in the Issue Department, represented partly by Coin and partly by Certificates of the Royal Mint (by whom the bulk of the Coin is held), will be found in Safe E in the Inner Treasury.

The Vaults S V 3 (Door 4) containing Gold and B 5 (Door 29) and S V 4 (Door 3) containing Silver must next be visited.

The number of bags must be counted, and the contents of at least one bag must be verified. For this purpose scales are available in the Vault.

Silver Coin-Banking.

A certificate of the amount of Silver held in the Vaults S V 4 and B 5 signed jointly by the Senior Cashier and the Principal of the In-Tellers' Office may be accepted. If Silver is deposited in the "Refinery" Vault at St. Luke's a similar certificate may be accepted.

A plan showing the general disposition of the Silver in S V 4 is kept in the Vault. The number of bags as shown on this plan should be checked into the Summary and the bags on at least two of the numbered shelves and on two trucks or platforms in a selected row should be counted. The number of bags on any platform or truck will be found on the back of the identifying Number Card of the row in question.

The details of any amount shown as "Less: Silver set aside" in the Balance Statement furnished to the Auditing Director should be verified as far as possible. Any amount set aside of "Silver Coin Reserve Account," should be checked with the books in the Chief Accountant's Office.

Agreement

Finally, the grand totals of the OUT CASH, Issue and Banking, must be agreed with the corresponding totals in the books of the Chief Accountant

N.B.—The total of the GOLD (Issue Department) held in the Out Cash should not exceed £6,000,000, exclusive of any sums in course of delivery to or from the Mint. Should it be found that this total is exceeded, the Chief Cashier must be called upon to furnish an explanation. There is no limit to the amount of SILVER which may be held in the Out Cash.
