Bank of England Euro Bills

The Bank of England today announced the issue of Euro 1,000 million nominal of Bank of England Euro Bills, for auction on a bid-yield basis on Tuesday, 10 April 2001, in the following maturities:

Euro 200 million for maturity on 10 May 2001,
Euro 500 million for maturity on 12 July 2001 and
Euro 300 million for maturity on 11 October 2001.

An additional Euro 50 million nominal of six-month Bills, maturing on 11 October 2001, will be allotted directly to the Bank of England. A copy of the auction notice published by the Bank is attached.

Statistics showing the turnover of Bank of England Euro Bills by market makers in March 2001 are attached.
