Bank of England Euro Bills

The Bank of England today announced the issue of Euro1,000 million nominal of Bank of England Euro Bills, for auction on a bid-yield basis on Tuesday, 13 February 2001, in the following maturities:

Euro200 million for maturity on 15 March 2001, Euro500 million for maturity on 10 May 2001 and Euro300 million for maturity on 16 August 2001.

An additional Euro50 million nominal of six-month Bills, maturing on 16 August 2001, will be allotted directly to the Bank of England. A copy of the auction notice published by the Bank is attached.

Statistics showing the turnover of Bank of England Euro Bills by market makers in January 2001 are attached.
