Adviser to the Governor of the Bank of England and Head of the Legal Unit

Malcolm Glover has been appointed Adviser to the Governor and Head of the Legal Unit, in succession to Len Berkowitz who retired at the end of January. Mr Glover will take up his appointment in June, following his retirement from Denton Wilde Sapte where he was a Partner.

Malcolm Glover is 57. He read law at Bristol University and qualified as a solicitor in 1968. He joined Wilde Sapte in 1970, becoming a partner in 1971. Between 1988 and 1999 he was Deputy Senior Partner, prior to the firm's merger with Denton Hall. He has extensive experience of banking issues.
