

ISO 20022 Change Management – November 2026: CHAPS DPs

Planned changes as at 19 December 2025

We have committed to annual upgrades to the ISO 20022 messages used in CHAPS and RTGS. This document contains the consolidated set of schema changes planned for inclusion in the CHAPS and RTGS ISO 20022 release scheduled for November 2026, relevant to CHAPS Direct Participants including Net Settlement participants.¹ This is an updated version of this document, first shared on 25 July 2025, following feedback from participants on change being driven by the Bank and further work by CBPR+ and HVPS+ to refine their change list.

We are sharing this information now so that organisations engaged in processing CHAPS and RTGS messages have visibility of the list of changes being planned as documented in our [Change Management Framework](#) and can continue to prepare for change implementation in November 2026.

This list includes changes to ensure continued interoperability with the Swift correspondent banking network (through CBPR+) and other high value payment systems (through HVPS+) as well as specific alterations we have identified ourselves or had requested by participants up to 1 April 2025.² Any requests received after 1 April 2025 will be considered for 2027 or later, and are detailed in the backlog.

Given the amount of ongoing change in CHAPS, RTGS and other payment systems, we are prioritising changes which support international alignment; these are those changes in the “Mandatory changes and Interoperability changes” tables. Note that there have been a small number of changes to these tables since July 2025, reflecting ongoing work by CBPR+ and HVPS+ to refine the list of changes.

² This deadline reflects the need for message changes to go through the ISO 20022 message change evaluation and registration processes.

We also share information about other changes we are planning to deliver in the section “Other Changes – planned for 2026”. Note that there have been some changes since July 2025 reflecting further work we have undertaken on our change capacity, and feedback from participants on prioritisation.

The changes which we do not plan to deliver in 2026 but which remain on our backlog are also shared, for visibility and for any necessary early planning beyond 2026 (in “Change Backlog – not included in 2026”). In particular we note, relevant for Payment System Operators and participants in deferred net settlement schemes, that we will not deliver the planned changes to the pacs.029, camt.054 and camt.053 to provide an optional reference field for individual movements within the settlement request in 2026 – this will however remain on our backlog for further consideration for future years. Please also note that our expectation is that changes for the November 2027 release will be mostly focused on the planned ISO 20022 base message upgrade.

We would suggest that this is reviewed by both your business and technical teams. RTGS participants should also share this document with relevant vendors and service providers where applicable to inform their response.

We are intending to share the draft schemas and technical guidance supporting these changes in late January 2026. These will be available via [MyStandards](#).

Summary of proposed changes

The tables below set out the change requests proposed for implementation in November 2026. The changes impact the machine-readable schema (xsd) files in MyStandards that form part of the Swift validation libraries that the Bank and participants use to validate CHAPS, RTGS and net settlement messages.

- The majority of changes proposed for 2026 are corrections, updates and additions to the existing CHAPS and RTGS ISO 20022 message schemas, aligning with the schema changes internationally with CBPR+ and HVPS+, and correcting previous misalignment.
- We are also planning introduction of new message types within RTGS, where participants will be able to request intraday camt.052.001 liquidity reports through the camt.060.001 Request message, and also the ability to cancel unsettled, and in particular forward dated and timed, CHAPS payments through the camt.056.001 payment cancellation request. The accompanying camt.029.001 resolution of investigation will be sent by RTGS in confirmation.

- All proposed changes have been assigned an impact categorisation – definitions for this are in [Annex A](#). This includes setting out whether these are new messages, changes to existing messages or changes to technical guidance. We have updated the table to identify the specific messages that we expect to be impacted by these changes.
- Within the part of the table “Other Changes – planned for 2026”, we have narrowed down the list shared in July 2025 reflecting both our internal capacity constraints and industry feedback. In particular we note, relevant for Payment System Operators and participants in deferred net settlement schemes, that we will not deliver the planned changes to the pacs.029, camt.054 and camt.053 to provide an optional reference field for individual movements within the settlement request in 2026 – this will however remain on our backlog for further consideration for future years.
- The “Change backlog – not included in 2026” gives visibility of requested changes we are not progressing in 2026, but which we will revisit for delivery in future years.
- Information on timelines outlining this process and provisional dates is documented in our [Change Management Framework](#).

Please read the document carefully to understand how the changes may impact you. We have provided information about which messages are expected to be impacted. Where an impacted message type is not specifically listed, this may be because the proposed change impacts multiple messages or is relevant to technical documentation. You should consult your message sets and documentation to establish impact where necessary.

Change requests in detail

The change requests listed here are updated from the indicative scope shared in July 2025 and should be considered the planned scope. It is possible that further changes may need to be made, particularly if CBPR+ and HVPS+ finalise their changes. We plan to share draft schemas and technical guidance in MyStandards in late January 2026. The final package will be shared at beginning April 2026.

Annex A: Swift impact level categorisation of the change requests

All change requests contain an evaluation of their impact on interfaces and applications expressed as a number in the range [0 - 3] with or without a plus “+” or minus “-” sign as in the following table.

Index of impact

Level 0	This is a minor change that does not impact the structure of the message, but it may have an impact on some automated applications, for example, the scope of the message is updated.
Level 1	This change relates to the use of the message syntax but does not affect the message structure or the message validation, for example, a definition or a usage rule is changed.
Level 1+	An existing message is removed from the service.
Level 2-	The change has a small effect on the message syntax and the message validation, for example, simple data types are changed.
Level 2+	The message syntax or the message validation or both are significantly impacted, for example, an element or a message component or a message building block is added or deleted, or a validation rule is changed or added.
Level 3-	A new message is added to the service.

Impact on interfaces

All changes can have a direct impact on interfaces. This also applies to level 0 and level 1 changes, which may require an update to input screens or help screens or both.

Impact on applications

Level 0 changes should have zero to minimal impact on applications. Higher level changes will normally have an impact on applications, although the impact for applications that send the message may be different from the impact for applications that receive the message.
