PRA RULEBOOK: INTERPRETATION (AMENDMENT) INSTRUMENT 2015

Powers exercised

- A. The Prudential Regulation Authority ("PRA") makes this instrument in the exercise of the following powers and related provisions in the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 ("the Act"):
 - (1) section 137G (the PRA's general rules); and
 - (2) section 137T (General supplementary powers).
- B. The rule-making powers referred to above are specified for the purpose of section 138G(2) (Rule-making instrument) of the Act.

Pre-conditions to making

C. In accordance with section 138J of the Act (Consultation by the PRA), the PRA consulted the Financial Conduct Authority. After consulting, the PRA published a draft of proposed rules and had regard to representations made.

D. The PRA makes the rules in the Annex to this instrument.

Commencement

E. This instrument comes into force on 6 March 2016.

Citation

F. This instrument may be cited as the PRA Rulebook: Interpretation (Amendment) Instrument 2015.
