

## Conference on financial statistics: November 1985

Annual conferences have been organised in recent years under the aegis of the Statistics Users' Council, with the object of promoting discussion between compilers and users of official statistics. The subject of this year's conference will be financial statistics: it will be held at the Royal Society, 6 Carlton House Terrace, London SW1 on Wednesday 13 November.

The programme, which has been arranged by the Bank of England in conjunction with representatives of producers and users of financial statistics from the public and private sectors, is provisional at this stage, but is expected to include the following:

### *Morning sessions*

- 1 Theme: **The current scene**  
Discussion of papers from HM Treasury and the Central Statistical Office
- 2 Theme: **Adaptation and change in UK financial statistics (domestic and external)**  
Discussion of papers from the Bank of England, the British Bankers' Association and the London Business School

### *Afternoon sessions*

- 3 Theme: **Industrial and commercial companies—problems and prospects**  
Discussion of papers from the Central Statistical Office, the Society of Investment Analysts and the Department of Applied Economics, Cambridge
- 4 **Panel discussion and open forum**

The conference will conclude with an evening reception.
